



Village of Lytton Virtual Community Consultation

The Village of Lytton is looking to gather the views and preferences of residents and stakeholders regarding Non- Medicinal Cannabis retail sales within Village Limits.

Phase 1. Public Engagement: Public engagement will gather the views and preferences of residents and stakeholders. The results will be published in an engagement summary at the end of Phase 3.

Public engagement has the following goals:

To gather the views of the public on if cannabis retail sales should be permitted within Village Limits and how cannabis retail sales should be regulated.

Phase 2. A survey will be posted on the Lytton.ca website to collect public opinion on policy options for cannabis retail sales, including whether cannabis retail sales should be permitted.

Depending on the results of public consultation phase 3 will be an informed development of a Cannabis Retail Sales Policy.

Phase 3. Development of Regulatory Framework: Based on the research conducted in Phase 1 and 2 results of public engagement and survey, a regulatory framework for cannabis retail sales. The framework addresses issues such as the prohibition or allowance of cannabis retail stores and a proposed retail model.
