OCP UPDATE WORK PROGRAM

What is an Official Community Plan?

- A vision, objectives and policies to guide decisions on planning and land use
- Policies consider land use directions for growth areas, sustainability initiatives, hazard and environment protection, housing, transportation, parks, and servicing directions.
- OCPs extensively include maps to designate land use and site attributes


Why Update the current Official Community Plan?




OCP UPDATE

- ✓ Document that is **flexible and user friendly**, in its implementation




TIMELINE: 12 months


- ✓ Meet prior to Project Launch to review and provide input on Work Program



✓ Ongoing Community Feedback


- Outreach to Nlaka'pamux, community groups, schools, investors, businesses, etc.


UPDATED VISION, OBJECTIVES + POLICIES

✓ Document Preparation

- Staff draws on community feedback, technical reporting and legislative requirements and drafts updated OCP
- Prepare maps to reflect and complement policy directions
- Amend and incorporate previous work done on development permit areas, following community vision, objectives and policies

✓ Present Draft OCP at Community Open House and Meeting

- Displays and presentation of OCP vision, objectives, policies, guidelines and maps
- Staff presentation of the key directions in the draft OCP
- Opportunities for community feedback on the draft document, and policy directions





UPDATED OCP APPROVAL PROCESS

✓ Bylaw Readings

- Staff introduces the updated OCP to Council
- Staff provides an overview of the Nlaka'pamux consultation and community engagement
- At second reading, Council sets public hearing date

✓ Public Hearing


Presentation of OCP vision, objectives, policies, guidelines and maps

- Provincial approvals
- Adoption








UPDATED OCP ROLL OUT

- ✓ Provide information to the community about the key directions of the new OCP
- ✓ Incorporate OCP Action Items into the Village budget and Annual Plan
- ✓ Update Village procedures, forms, and applications to align with the new OCP
- ✓ Proceed with Zoning Bylaw Update to ensure alignment
- ✓ Proceed with Economic Development Strategy and Action Plan
- ✓ Introduce an annual monitoring program on the OCP Action Items
