- Located at 320, 400, and 420 Fraser Street.
- Envisioned as an accessible and inclusive gathering space for residents of the Village of Lytton and surrounding areas
- \$25.9 million in funding through the federal Green and Inclusive Community Buildings Program.

## Engagement opportunities

- Open house
- Survey

## Comments supporting project:

- Replace lost community spaces, and provide place for community gathering, recreation, and youth
- Improve recreational opportunities for health and wellbeing of community (pool and fitness centre/programs)
- Encourage economic growth and attract residents and visitors



**73% of respondents supported** proceeding with project once federal funding requirements were met.

# JANUARY 2025

## What we heard



### **Gaps noted in concept plan**

- *Fitness/recreation centre*
- *Parking and electric vehicle (EV) charging*
- *Additional electrical hookups for markets and events*
- *Quiet place/room*
- *Inclusion of museum and library*

### **Important considerations**

- Financial viability, operations, and maintenance
- Partnerships and collaboration with Nlaka'pamux to avoid redundancies
- Expediting the project and providing additional opportunities for input

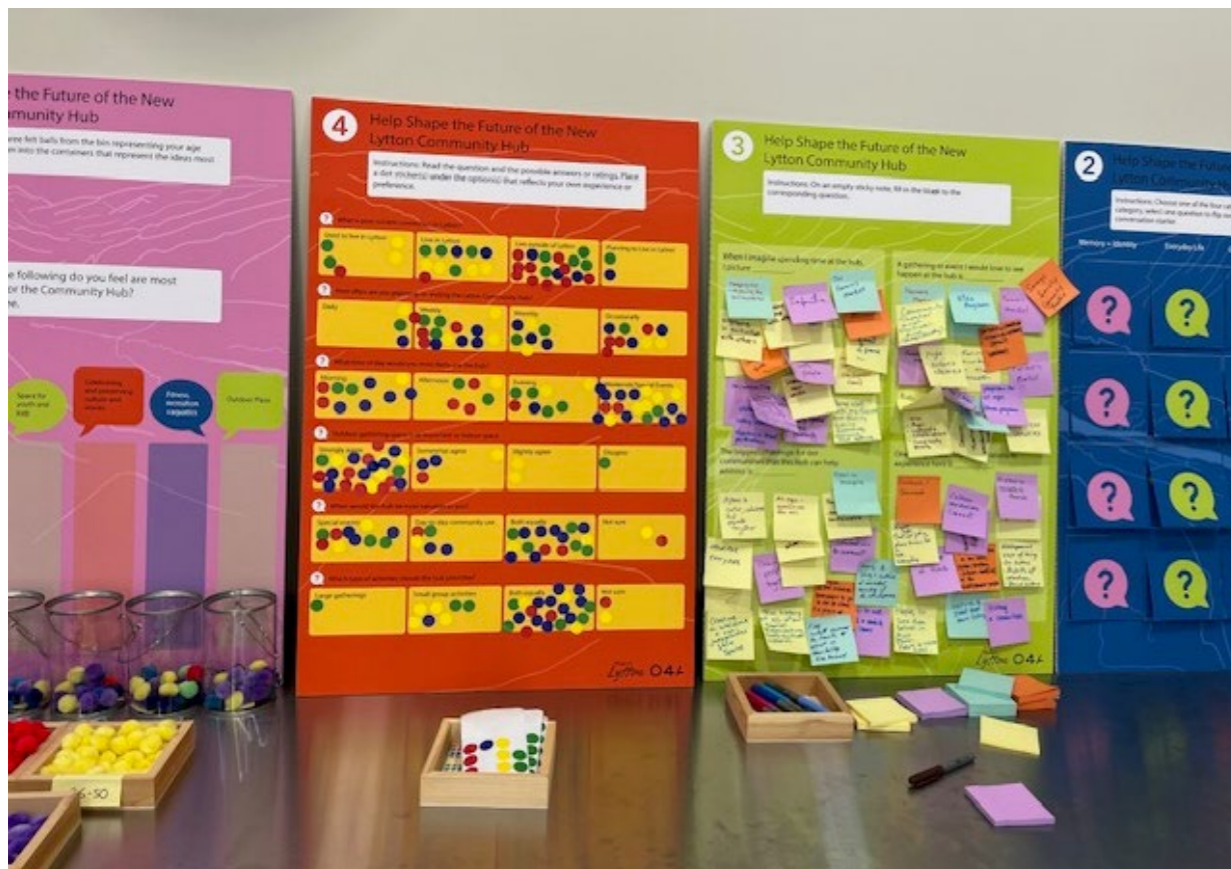

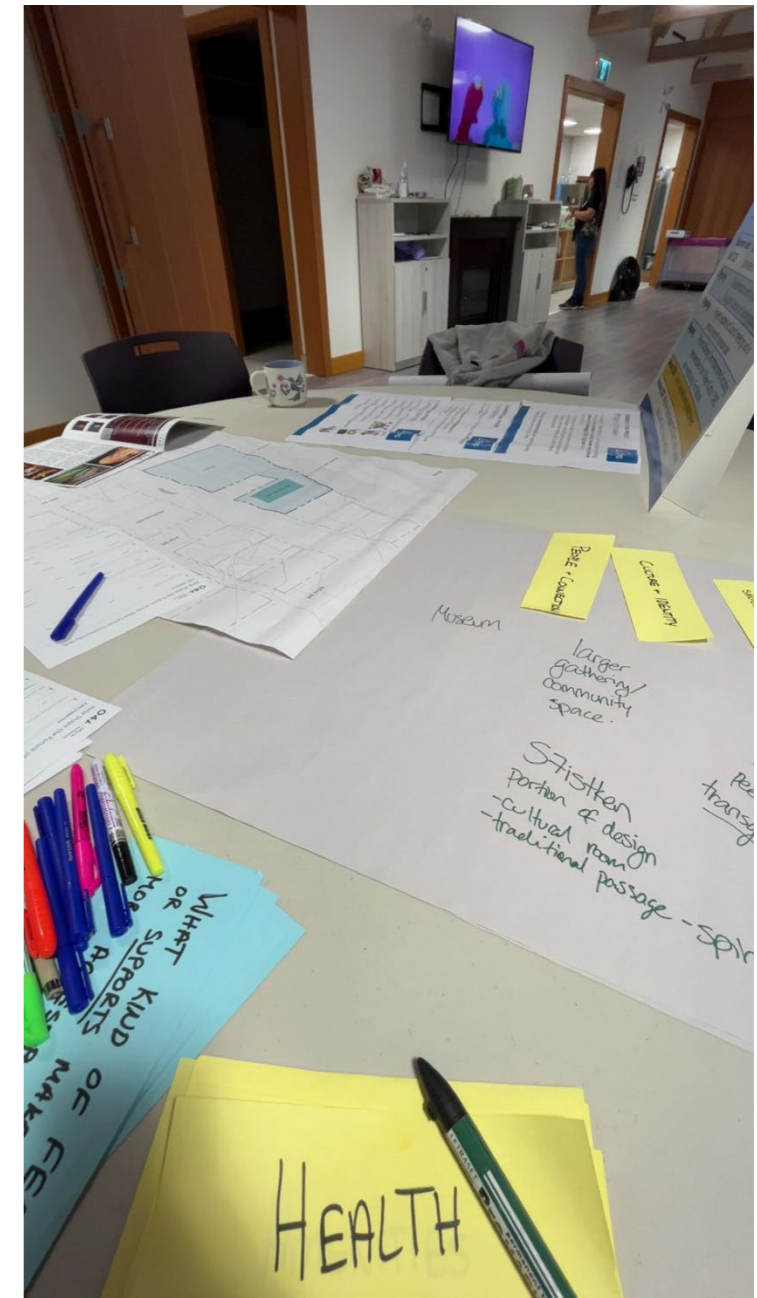
# NLAKA'PAMUX ENGAGEMENT OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 2025



## What we heard

### Include in the Community Hub:

- Inclusive aquatic area
- Flexible gathering area (>200 capacity) flows from interior to exterior
- Reflection space (Nlaka'pamux history and heritage)
- Flexible multi-use rooms (health and wellness, youth, creative spaces)
- Outdoor shaded gathering space
- Climate-resilient

## Future engagement

- Look and feel of the spaces within the Community Hub, including artwork or cultural spaces
- Specific uses in the building like the museum, pool, and library
- Celebrations for project milestones
