



## NOTICE FROM THE VILLAGE OF LYTTON

# BOIL WATER NOTICE

June 19, 2026

The Village of Lytton advises that due to the impacts of the Saw Creek fire on the Village of Lytton's water system, a **Boil Water Notice is required**.

The water supply for locations listed below are under **Boil Water Notice** from June 19, 2026, **until further notice**.

This notice affects all users, however, people with weakened or undeveloped immune systems are most at risk. This includes elderly people, pregnant women and their unborn, children under the age of 2, people with AIDS, cancer, diabetes or kidney disease and people being treated with immune-suppressing medications.

As a precautionary measure, water users are advised to **bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute before using it for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, food preparation, etc.**
