# EVACUATION ORDER AMENDMENT

### Saw Creek Wildfire

**June 21, 2026, 1900 hours**

WHEREAS a State of Local Emergency was declared on June 19, 2026 pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to Saw Creek Wildfire within the jurisdiction of the Village of Lytton;

AND WHEREAS an Amended Evacuation Order (Order JO-037) was made by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District on behalf of the Village of Lytton to Section 107 (1) (c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, effective June 20, 2026 at 1300 hrs for Village of Lytton due to the Saw Creek Wildfire;

AND WHEREAS the area threatened by Saw Creek Wildfire has reduced;

The Amended Evacuation Order (JO-037) is repealed and hereby **replaced** by this Amended Evacuation Order (JO-41), effective as of June 21, 2026 at 1900 hrs. This Evacuation Order is now in place for approximately 3 addressed properties in the Village of Lytton.

- properties South of, but not including, Kumsheen ShchEma-meet School; and
- any other properties as outlined in the attached map.

If you are in the described area, **you must leave immediately**. A person must not enter the Evacuation Order area for purposes of residing, occupying, or visiting the area.

#### What You Should Do:

- To receive Emergency Support Services (ESS), please self-register through the Evacuee Registration & Assistance tool: [ess.gov.bc.ca](https://ess.gov.bc.ca)
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, keys) if they are immediately available. Take your grab-and-go bag if you have one prepared.
- Transport pets in kennels or on a leash.
- Close gate latches, but do not lock gates.

- Do not turn off your natural gas. FortisBC will turn off natural gas service as needed.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you need to.
- If you require transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this emergency notice, or call the TNRD at: 250-377-7188.
- Arrange to stay with family or friends (if possible).

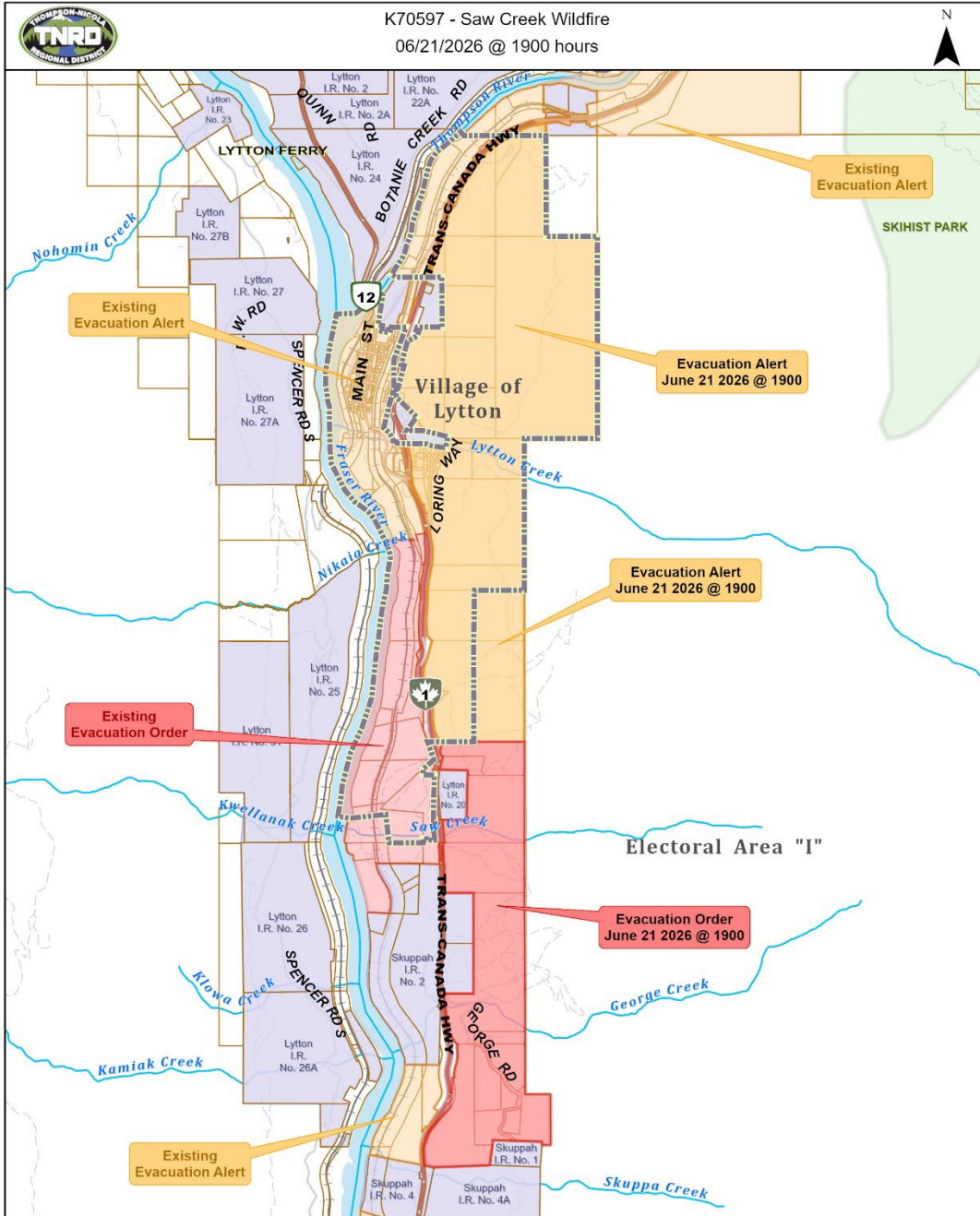
