1. How do I get archaeological information about my property?

Submit a <u>BC Archaeological Information Request Form</u>. Complete the required fields marked with an asterisk (*) and click the 'Submit Form' button located at the bottom of the page.

2. Why do I need to submit a BC Archaeological Information Request Form?

Due to their sensitive nature, information regarding archaeological sites is not shared publicly. When you submit an Information Request, you are agreeing to information sharing terms and conditions. This allows the Archaeology Branch to provide property owners with important archaeological information specific to their property.

3. Where do I go to access the BC Archaeological Information Request Form?

4. What do residents without access to a computer or who are otherwise unable to submit electronically do?
