Safe Return

The Village continues to be under a state of emergency; "what's the emergency"? Why are we hazardous? "Hazards continue to require use of the emergency powers to regulate persons or property to protect the health, safety, or welfare of people or to limit damage to property." I think that Work safe BC has outlined how to protect self. Please show recent test results to validate this statement.

A State of Emergency is a circumstance in which government officials determine that there is a threat to the safety of the citizens of a community or region. During such a time, officials may implement procedures to protect or provide care for the affected population until the threat has diminished. It also allows for the community to continue to receive required funding for recovery in the disaster.
