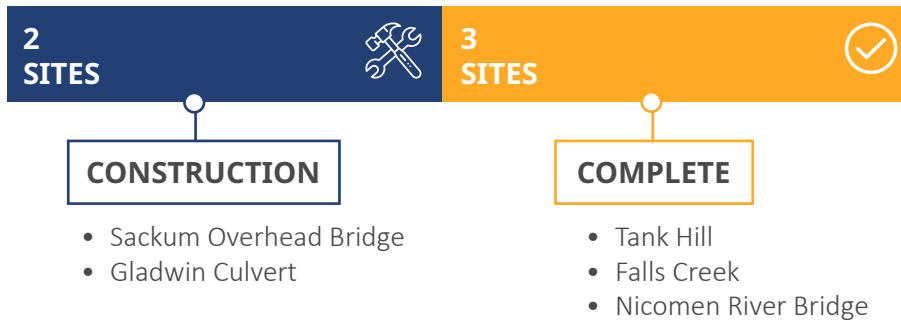


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PERMANENT REPAIR UPDATE

Permanent repairs are underway on Highway 1 to return the highway to full capacity. Construction is complete on the Tank Hill project, which is now open to three lanes of vehicle traffic and all crews have demobilized from site. Work on the Sackum Overhead Bridge and Gladwin Culvert projects will start soon.

Tank Hill open to three lanes

Location: Approximately 14 km east of Lytton

All construction activities on the overpass are now complete and the highway is open to three lanes of traffic. The newly constructed bridge has restored grade separation between the highway and the railway, which will improve safety, reliability and resiliency to future events.

CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY AT GLADWIN CULVERT

Location: 10 km east of Lytton

Construction has started on the Gladwin Culvert replacement. Work will include replacement of the temporary culverts with a permanent engineered culvert, repairs to the roadway and reinforcement of the channel. Currently, a temporary two-lane detour bridge is being built to re-route traffic during construction. Cultural monitors from multiple Indigenous communities in the area are on site to support and supervise work.
